What can I get help with?

There are often costs associated with starting college for example books, uniform, equipment and essential trips. Chelmsford College is committed to supporting learners who are experiencing financial hardship to enable them to commence their studies.

If you received FSM at school you will need to apply to The 16-19 Bursary Fund for this support to continue.

Once you have enrolled onto your course for the academic year 2025-2026 (24 hours after enrolment) you will then be able to log into your Chelmsford College email account and complete an online application for the college bursary
