## What is Learning Support?

The college is committed to helping young people with SEND to increase their independence and develop strategies to achieve success, enjoy college and prepare for adult life.

If any of the following applies to you please let us know by <u>completing and</u> <u>submitting this form</u> so we are aware of any adjustments you may require to access your programme of study:

- a special educational need, one plan or SEN support at school
- a current Educational Health & Care Plan
- you are home educated
- you are currently with an alternative provider/tuition
- you have challenges accessing school full time or you are on a reduced timetable

For special exam arrangements, you will have the opportunity to request these at enrolment.

## **Special Arrangements for Exams**

- You will be given the opportunity to ask for these these when you enrol.
- You may be required to provide evidence to support your request and we strongly suggest gathering these documents over the summer to meet the deadline of 19<sup>th</sup> September.

Types of evidence you may need to provide:

- If you have previously had exam arrangements, please obtain a copy of this evidence from school (Form 8 or 9, AAO and a copy of the assessor's qualifications).
- If you need to take your exam in a smaller room you need to ask your GP for a letter to support this.
- If you have a diagnosis of SEND or other condition you will be asked to provide a copy.
