Post 16 Transport (reduced rate available where criteria for low income is met)

You can apply for Post 16 Transport Assistance from Essex County Council if you are:

- Under 19 at the beginning of the academic year (1 September)
- Attending a full time study programme at a school, sixth form or college that is funded by the Education Funding Agency
- Living over 3 miles away from the school/college you have chosen
- Attending the nearest maintained establishment at which the programme, or the majority of the programme, is offered

Chelmsford College Discounted Travel Scheme

Full-time learners enrolled on a Study Programme and travelling from the areas covered by our travel scheme can apply to use the discounted College Travel Scheme. The scheme covers travel using local First Bus Ltd commercial service routes, see map on www.firstgroup.com and selected Greater Anglia railway routes only.

First Bus Ltd travel will be in the form of **MTicketing** which are mobile tickets uploaded directly to your mobile phone. Travel passes can still be purchased via the college where students do not have access to a mobile phone.

Replacement passes can be ordered from the appropriate travel operator.

N.B. You are required to carry your college I.D. card with you at all times whilst using your scholar travel card on Greater Anglia routes.
