Purpose of the Role

- Assess learners' practical competence in workshops and the workplace using a range of assessment methods.
- Provide timely, constructive feedback that supports learner progress and achievement.
- Monitor learner attendance, progress and achievement, implementing interventions where required.
- Prepare apprentices and students for successful completion of qualifications and End Point Assessment (EPA).

Employer Engagement

- Develop and maintain effective working relationships with employers and industry partners.

- Undertake workplace visits to assess apprentices and review learner progress.
- Support employers in developing apprentices' knowledge, skills and behaviours.
- Promote the College's Electrical Installation provision and contribute to employer engagement activities.

Curriculum Development

- Contribute to the design, review and continuous improvement of the Electrical Installation curriculum.
- Ensure learning materials reflect current industry practice, legislation and emerging technologies.
- Share industry expertise and contribute to innovation within the curriculum.
